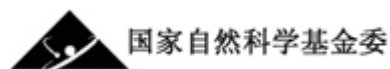

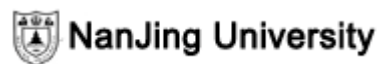

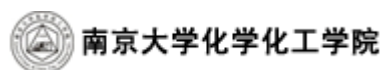

Dear Colleagues,



Conference Venue

The Conference will be held in Jinling Riverside Conference Hotel in Nanjing, China (<http://www.jinlinghotels.com/EN/memberhotels/Riverside/portal.asp>). It is the 5-star deluxe gardenlike hotel near Yangtze River in Nanjing.

Accommodation

Blocks of rooms will be reserved for all participants in Jinling Riverside Conference Hotel (金陵江滨国际会议中心酒店), where the conference will be held, and Jiangsu International Trade Hotel (江苏国贸国际大酒店, the same hotel as we announced before), which is about 4 km away from the conference site. Shuttle bus will be provided by the conference to pick up the attendees who stay in the second hotel.

1. **Jinling Riverside Conference Hotel.** The room rates including breakfast are as follows:

Single Room: 400 RMB yuan; \$ 60

Double Room: 400 RMB yuan (200 yuan/person); \$ 60 (30 dollars/person)

Double Room, King Size Bed: 600 RMB yuan ; \$ 90

Super Luxury Suite: 1000 RMB yuan ; \$ 150

2. **Jiangsu International Trade Hotel,** No.289 Jiangdongzhonglu Road (南京市建邺区江东中路 289 号, 奥体中心东门对面). The room rates including breakfast are as follows:

Single Room: 320 RMB yuan; \$ 46

Double Room: 320 RMB yuan (160 yuan/person); \$ 46 (23 dollars/person)

The accommodation can be paid either in cash or by credit card on arrival.

Registration

The registration desk is located in the main hall of Jinling Riverside Conference Hotel. It will open in the whole day of 31st October (8:30 am to 10:00 pm). Conferees arrive after 31st October, please get registered at the Secretariat Office in the hotel.

For student participants, proof of your student status, e.g. a valid student ID or a formal letter of certificate from the University is required for discounted registration fee announced in the early circular of the conference and on our websites.

Conference Format

The conference lectures, poster sessions are all in the same conference center.

The conference will feature plenary lectures (50 min), Keynote Lectures (35 min, including discussion), Invited Lectures (25 min, including discussion), Oral Lectures (20 min, including discussion) and poster sessions. The lectures except plenary lectures are arranged as four paralleled sessions. Detailed information is available in the Scientific Program.

Oral Presentation

Speakers should prepare their presentation in MS-Power Point format. Speakers are kindly asked to check their own lecture time in Scientific Program and provide their presentation file in advance to the conference secretariat for format compatibility checking. Speakers who wish to use their own laptop computers are kindly requested to contact the conference secretariat in advance.

Poster Presentation

There will be two poster sessions, one in the afternoon of Nov. 1st (Sunday, 17:20-18:45) and the other in the afternoon of Nov. 3rd (Tuesday, 17:15-18:45). Each poster will be assigned to a number which will be available on arrival.

Six poster prizes will be awarded, three for *Dalton Transactions*, and the other three for RSC. The standard size for the poster should be 120 cm × 90 cm. The Local Organizing Committee (LOC) will supply facilities for poster displaying.

Language

The official language of the conference is English.

How to get to Jinling Riverside Conference Hotel

Free shuttle service is available for arrival on October 31st and for departure on November 4th from the Olympic Stadium Station (奥体中心站) (terminal station of Metro Line 1) to Jinling Riverside Conference Hotel. The Metro operates from 6:00am to 11:00pm. You may exit the Olympic Stadium Station from Exit No. 3. Volunteers from the LOC will provide guidance to the shuttle bus. It takes about 3 min from the Metro station to the hotel.

If your arrival time is not in the above mentioned period, you may walk to the hotel following the second map given below. In this way, you should exit from Exit No. 6 of the Metro station. The distance from Metro station to the hotel is about 1.5 KM.

1. If you arrive at Nanjing Lukou International Airport, you may take following transportations (volunteers of the conference will provide guidance at the airport).

- a) **Taxi.** The taxi can take you directly to Nanjing Riverside Conference Hotel (金陵江滨国际会议中心酒店) and the fare is about 100 RMB yuan. You may show the second map given below to the taxi driver.
- b) **Airport shuttle bus.** Take the bus and transfer at Zhong-Hua-Men Metro Station (中华门站). The shuttle bus costs 25 RMB yuan/person. You can then take a taxi to the Nanjing Riverside Conference Hotel. The fare is about 30 Yuan. The shuttle bus station is about several hundred meters away from the Metro station, you can take the Metro to the Olympic Stadium. The fare for the metro is 2 RMB yuan/person. Metro ticket is available from either the ticket machine or the metro ticket office.

2. If you arrive at the Nanjing Railway Station (南京火车站), you may take the following transportations:

- a) **Metro.** Get off the train at Nanjing Railway Station. The Metro station is within the Nanjing Railway Station. Take the Metro and get off at Olympic Stadium Station. The fare is 4 RMB yuan/person. Metro ticket is available from either the ticket machine or the metro ticket office.
- b) **Taxi.** The taxi can take you directly to Nanjing Riverside Conference Hotel (金陵江滨国际会议中心酒店) and the fare is about 50 RMB yuan. Please show the second map to the taxi driver.

The volunteers of the conference will help you to find taxi or Metro Station at the arrival gate of the railway station.

3. If you arrive at other sites, please follow the instructions below:

- a) Take a taxi directly to Jinling Riverside Conference Hotel (金陵江滨国际会议中心酒店). You may show the second map to the taxi driver.
- b) Find the nearest Metro station, and get to Olympic Stadium Station.

4. If you live in the Jiangsu International Trade Hotel (江苏国贸国际大酒店):

Go to Jinling Riverside Conference Hotel. We will arrange shuttles to send you to your hotel (Maps 1 and 2).

5. Note for International participants who arrive at Shanghai and Beijing

There are direct flights between Nanjing (Lukou International Airport) and Beijing.

If you arrive at Shanghai Pudong International Airport, then you have the following choices:

- 1) By train: You can take a shuttle bus (No. 5) at the Pudong International Airport to the Shanghai Railway Station. The trip is about 40 minutes, and the ticket is about 22 RMB. Then you can buy a train ticket to Nanjing. The fastest train will take about 2 hours from Shanghai to Nanjing. These trains are numbered with capital D followed by four digits. The tickets are about 93-112 RMB, depending on the type of the train and the rank of the seat.

2) By bus: There is a “long distance bus stop” outside the Pudong airport, just in 5 minutes’ walking distance (ask the staff at the airport for the “long distance bus stop” or simply “bus to Nanjing” to know the concrete stop site). Please query Shanghai Pudong International Airport to check the schedule before your trip. The ticket is about 122 RMB. It will take you 4 hours from the Pudong airport to Nanjing.

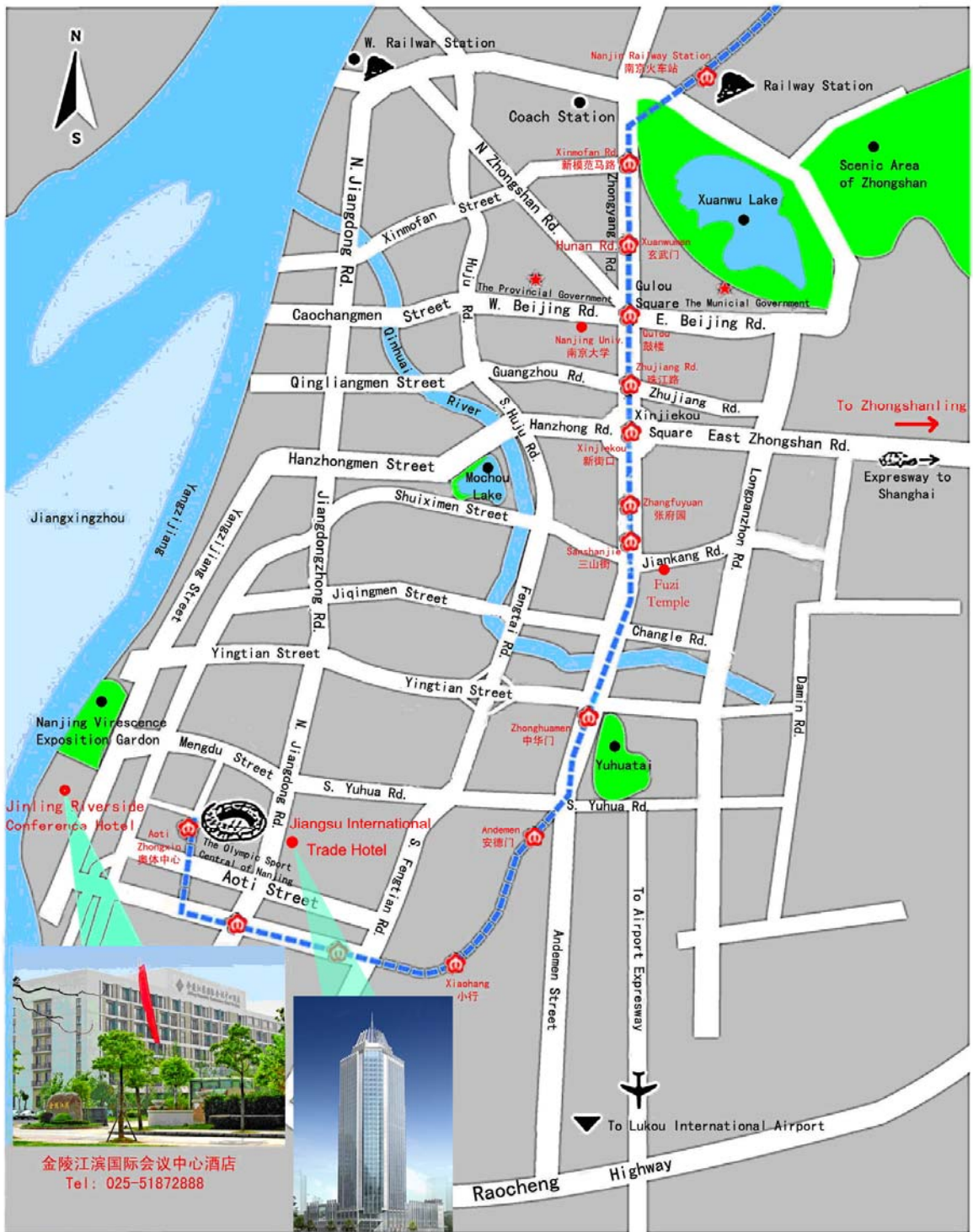
Internet Access at Jinling Riverside Conference Hotel

The wireless network is available inside the hotel and ADSL network is also available in each room free of charge.

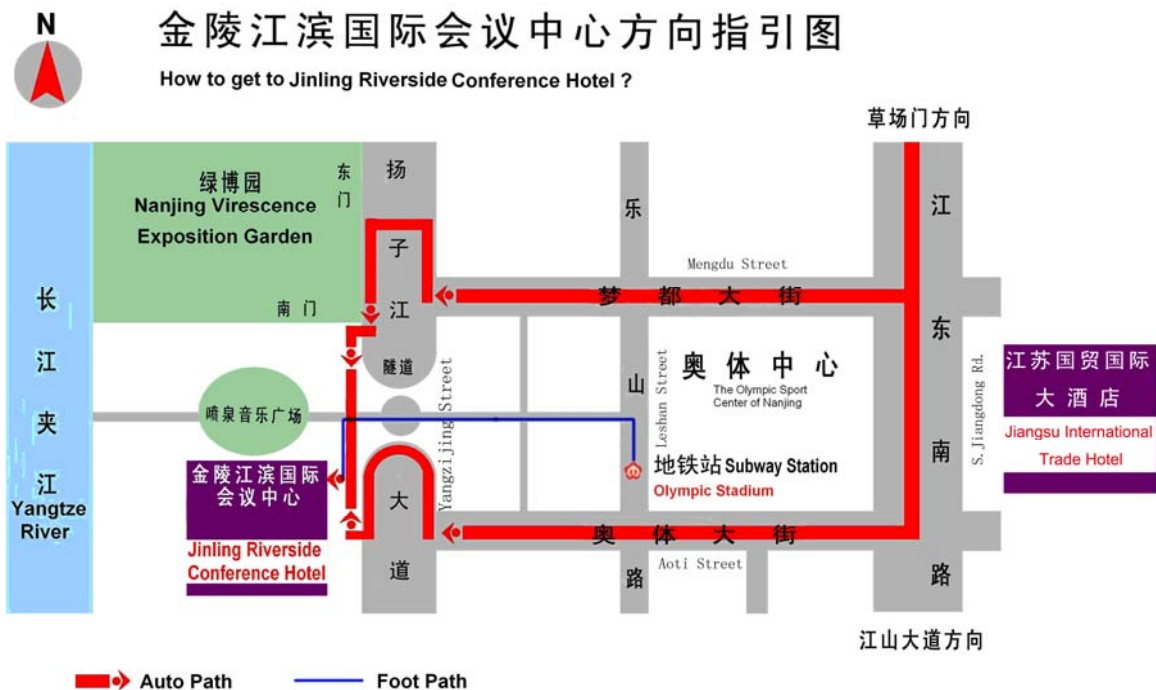
A conference internet point will be organized by LOC. It will be open from 9:00am of Nov. 1st October and accessible between 8: 30 - 21: 00 during the conference.

Passport and Visa

Non-Chinese citizens need a visa to enter China. To make your trip to China an easy and pleasant one, you are kindly advised to consult the local Chinese Embassies or Consulates-General (<http://www.fmprc.gov.cn/eng/ljzg/3647/>) first for travel information. They will readily help you go through the necessary procedures.

Social Program

Welcome Dinner in the evening of November 1st (19:00 – 21:00) at **Yanboyugan Restaurant** (烟波渔港). Shuttle bus will be arranged by the conference.

Conference Banquet for all participants in the evening of November 3rd (18:45 -21:00) at the **Yangtze River Hall** of Jinling Riverside Conference Hotel. Because of the space limitation, banquet tickets (100 RMB/person) have to be purchased in advance from the conference secretariat on registration desk, which will follow “first come, first served” basis.

Tourist

Three post-conference tours will be organized with reduced rates depending on the number of requests for all participants and accompanying persons. You are encouraged to email us about your choice to acc2@nju.edu.cn in advance. You may also register for the tourist at the registration desk after your arrival.

Itinerary 1: Yellow Mountain, 3 days, 1000~1500 RMB.

Natural spectacle: Nanjing-Yellow Mountain- Nanjing (3 days). The departure time is at 7: 00am. It takes about 6 hours from Nanjing to Yellow Mountain by bus. The fare is 1000-1500 RMB yuan/person (Including the transportation, tickets, accommodation, meals, etc.).
